Immigration and security in Europe

On 20-21 April, the Altius Foundation Spain, leader of the project "Active European Citizens for a Stronger EU", took part in the third working meeting to discuss migration and security in Europe.

Immigration and security are issues of concern to citizens of all member states so partners from Spain, Germany, France, Italy, Greece, Bulgaria, Cyprus and Lithuania have presented the current situation and opinions on how immigration affects their daily lives, employment, education, integration, etc. and how the government at national, regional and local level develops participation and integration of immigrants.
