SHORT HISTORY OF GERMAN DEMOCRACY

- First German democracy: Weimar Repub
- 1918 1933, Golden Twenties
- Constitution was flawed
- Nazi-party exploited it to gain power
- Result: third Reich 1933 1945









SHORT HISTORY OF GERMAN DEMOCRACY

Germany is divided in FRG (west) and GDR (east)

FDR is democratic state

GDR is not really democratic, despite its name

Reunion in 1990

Only since then democracy in whole of Germany









E-DEMOCRACY IN GERMANY ELECTRONIC VOTING

- Tested on a few occasions
- E.g. online voting for federal parliament in Hamburg 2008
- Always cancelled by constitutional court
- Suspected safety risks







E-DEMOCRACY IN GERMANY ONLINE PETITIONS

- Possible on website of the parliament
- Every viable petition gets checked
- 50.000+ supporters: creator can speak in front of committee
- Example: petition for more climate protection 2020








E-DEMOCRACY IN GERMANY BÜRGERHAUSHALT — PARTICIPATORY BUDGETING

- Bürgerhaushalt = citizen budget
- Citizens decide on what project money is spent on
- Iterative process
- Example: my hometown Zella-Mehlis













E-DEMOCRACY IN GERMANY E-TRANSPARENCY — ABGEORDNETENWATCH.DE

- Abgeordneter = member of parliament
- Non-profit website
- Has information about all parliament members
- Possibility to publicly ask questions
- Enables citizens to inform themselves and control parliament members they voted for





THE FUTURE OF E-DEMOCRACY IN GERMANY

- Germany is behind most other EU-countries regarding digital infrastructure
- Process might take a while
- Innovations like electronic ID card can help the process
