Spain is one of the countries at the forefront of digital democracy (The Guardian)

In Spain, several cities have launched citizen participation portals, where residents can propose actions, vote on them and debate.

The first to do so was Madrid, with its <u>Decide Madrid</u> platform. This platform allows the inhabitants of the Spanish capital to **participate directly** in the democracy process. It also allows citizens to **interact** with councilors and other members of the municipal corporation.

It is necessary to improve E-Democracy in Spain both at autonomous community level and at national level **Every citizen deserves to be heard**


E-Democracy in Spain: The impact of COVID-19 Pandemic

A project of the Spanish government financed by the European Union for the digital transformation of the country

Aims to operate in three dimensions:

- Infrastructure and Technology: better connectivity, 5G, cybersecurity, artificial intelligence and other disruptive technologies.
- **Economy:** digitization of SMEs and public administrations, digital entrepreneurship, integration of technology in industrial value chains and in the audiovisual sector.
- People: promoting the development of digital skills to access to the careers of the future and the digital inclusion of the entire population, ensuring the protection of people's rights in the digital environment.
