



IT INVOLVES RETHINKING TRADITIONAL MODELS OF DEMOCRACY AND EXPLORING INNOVATIVE WAYS TO ENGAGE CITIZENS, PROMOTE PARTICIPATION, ENHANCE TRANSPARENCY, AND ADDRESS DEMOCRATIC DEFICITS.



# THE DEFINITION OF E-DEMOCRACY

- Usage of digital tools and platforms to facilitate democratic processes.
- It involves leveraging technology to enhance citizen participation, engagement, and decision-making in the democratic governance of a society.
- It aims to make democratic processes more accessible, transparent, efficient, and inclusive by utilizing various online platforms and tools.



#### **Online Platforms and E-democracy:**

Digital technologies offer opportunities for citizens to engage in decision-making processes through online platforms. These platforms enable citizens to provide feedback, participate in consultations, submit proposals, and vote on policy issues. - Enhanced Transparency: Digital platforms can significantly improve transparency in democratic processes. By promoting transparency, edemocracy fosters trust between citizens and the government, ultimately strengthening the democratic system.
  - Efficiency and Cost Reduction: E-democracy streamlines administrative processes and reduces paperwork. Digital platforms enable faster and more efficient communication between citizens and government representatives, facilitating prompt feedback and information dissemination.

#### ADVANTAGES OF E-DEMOCRACY

#### Examples:






### ...MORE EXAMPLES
