# Participation of Greek people in EP elections

- In the 2019 European
   Parliament elections 58,69%
   of total voters came and voted in these elections.
- o In the 2014 EP elections the percentage of voters was 59,33%.
- Last but not least, in the 2009 elections, 52,54% of people voted.



## **Expectations of Greek voters**

O Greek voters expect the MEPs they elect to fight for the things that are most necessary for the greek people. Thus, we see that the Greek MEPs, alongside MEPs from countries that form the external border of the EU, like Bulgaria, Spain, Italy etc., demand more European help to combat illegal migration and to help these countries financially and for the other EU to receive more refugees. In this context, Greece, alongside other countries, asks for a stronger FRONTEX and a more active one in order to help local authorities to rescue migrants.







## **Expectations of Greek voters**

Moreover, Greek voters expect the European parliament to express its full solidarity to Greece (and Cyprus) against any illegal activities of other countries, like for example, against Turkey when it violates the Greek airspace of the greek of Cypriot Exclusice Economic Zones.








## Expectations of Greek voters

- 9 September: EU signs second MFA programme for Jordan (€200 million)
- O July: EU disburses €100 million in assistance to Tunisia
- 5 June: EU agrees MFA to the Republic of Moldova (up to €100 million)
