Definition

Disinformation:

a form of propaganda involving the dissemination of false information with the deliberate intent to deceive or mislead



Disinformation VS Misinformation

- **Disinformation:** the fake news that Bulgarian students will be subjected to military training to go fight against Russia in Ukraine.
- **Misinformation:** A worker in DW media tells how even the Bulgarian tourism minister fell for the lie that in Western Europe people are banned from bathing and promoted his country as a place where there is no such ban.

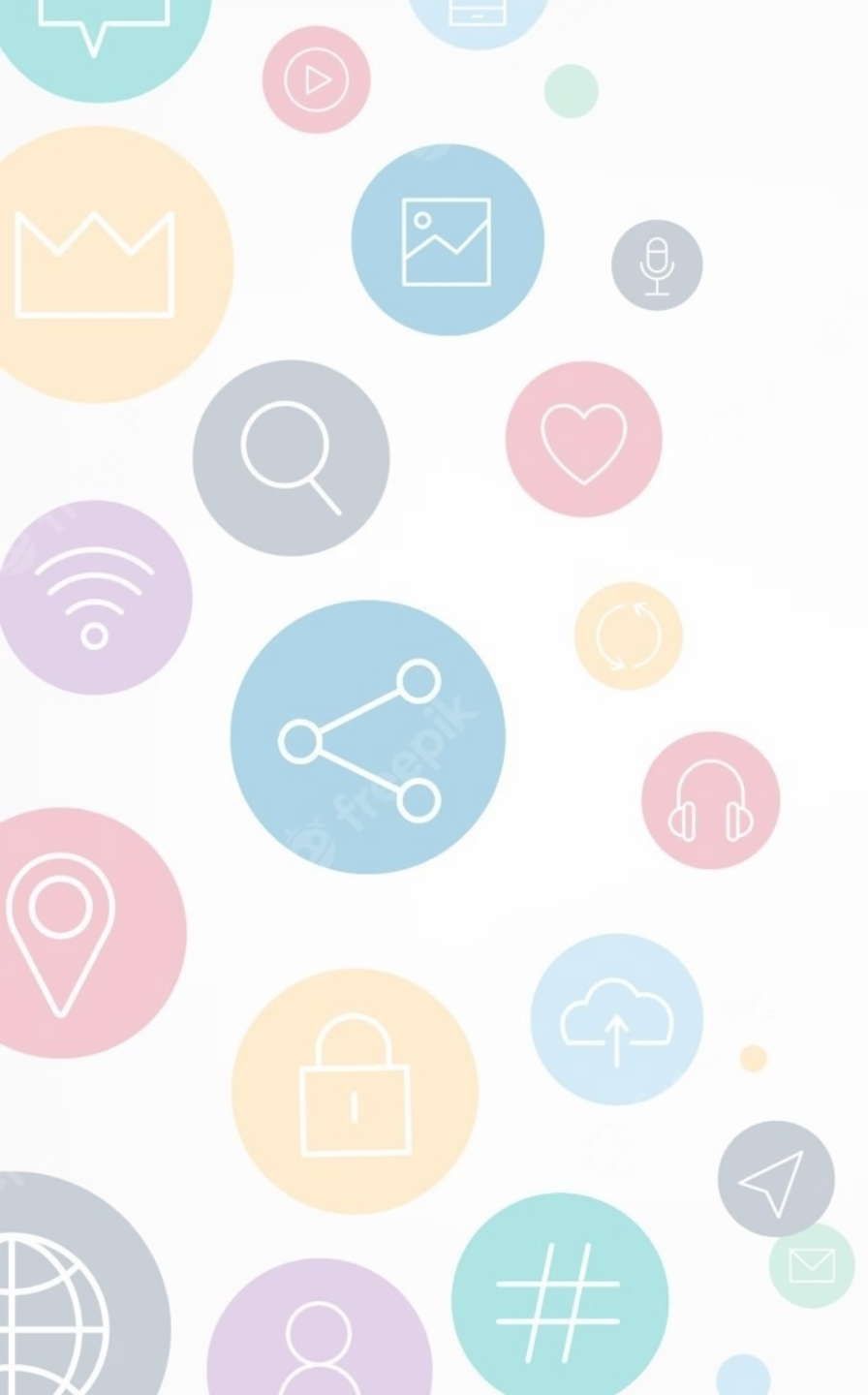
