Last Working Meeting of the ACT Stronger EU Project Led by Fundación Altius May 17, held at Europe Direct Berlin (Germany)

### Seminar and Debate on the Participation of Youth and Seniors in European Democratic Life

Fundación Altius Spain, leader of the project “Active European Citizens Towards a Stronger EU,” actively participated in the last in-person event of the project in the European debate on the democratic participation of seniors and youth (the future of Europe). The event was held in collaboration with Europe Direct Berlin, which gave a presentation on the services of the European information and communication center, and opened the event with a talk on the upcoming European Parliament elections and the need to mobilize all European citizens.

Fundación Altius Spain presented on the importance of participating in European democratic life, affecting important aspects of citizens' everyday lives regardless of age (environmental protection and climate change, education, new skills, improving working conditions, immigration and security, as well as consolidating the European way of life based on well-being, sustainability, and solidarity). The rest of the project partners, Germany, Bulgaria, Italy, Greece, Cyprus, Lithuania, and France, reflected on the democratic participation of youth and seniors to address the future challenges of Europeans.
